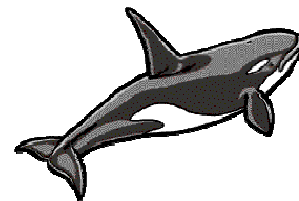

### Today's Agenda

**0800, Skippers' Meeting.** Meeting on the party float on the visitor's dock to discuss the cruise to Friday Harbor.

**0900, Depart for Cruise to Friday Harbor.** The fleet departs on individual schedules for Friday Harbor on San Juan Island. Please plan on arrival before 1300; otherwise you must dock on your own.

**Morning, and Afternoon, Friday Harbor. On Your Own.** Enjoy the charms of Friday Harbor's shops and museums.

**1800-2200, San Juan County Fairgrounds - Reception and Awards Banquet.** Buses will transport everyone to the fairgrounds for the gala awards banquet. A cash bar operated by the Friday Harbor squadron will be open during the reception and for wine purchases. The bar will sell margaritas, red and white wine, and beer. A sit-down dinner follows. Entertainment is provided by Uncle Otto (not Rasmussen).

### Buses to Friday Night Banquet

Buses leave from the traffic circle in the parking lot at the SW corner of the marina at 1745. Please be on time since there is not a second round of transportation. The walking distance to the Fairgrounds is about two miles, uphill.

Also, it takes at least 10 minutes to walk from the far end of the guest docks to the traffic circle in the marina parking lot. Plan ahead and leave the boat by 1730 or earlier.
